

# MRS. T. POPPLE – Rules and Expectations – History, Law, Civics/Careers

Please refer to your student handbook for any questions on school/board policies. Below are rules and expectations which are used in this classroom.



You are expected to arrive to class on time! Please bring a note regarding your lateness and/or absence to class with you. If you are frequently late there will be a consequence (detentions, parent contact, Vice-Principal involvement). Your success in class is directly tied to you being in class for all lessons.

**\*\*If you are absent on a test day you must provide a note from your parent/guardian the day you return, stating he/she knew you missed a test during your absence. A mark of zero will result if you do not write your test the day of your return.**



You must come to class prepared each day. This means that you will need your notebook, textbook, pens, pencils, highlighters, paper, all assignments daily.

\* When an assignment is due DO NOT come to class and expect to then print off the assignment. Print your work the night before or print it before class in guidance or in the library! Issues come up, be sure your parents contact me explaining any problems with assignments.



Food and drinks are permitted in the classroom on the following conditions:

- No sunflower/safflower oil products (ruffles, lays, sun chips, etc.) I have a severe allergy to these products. I am also allergic to all nuts but feel free to bring in granola bars and such to snack on...just no mixed nuts or whole nuts please. Cafeteria and vending machine items are NOT safe!
- Check with me before you eat please!**
- You must clean up after yourself.



Cell phones will not be tolerated at inappropriate times. If they are used in class you will be asked to put it away, if used again a detention will be assigned. Parents can contact the office, who will then call up to class, if there is an emergency.



Late assignments will not be tolerated.  $\frac{1}{3}$  of a level will be deducted daily until the work is returned (weekends count as individual days). A mark of zero will be given once the work is returned. You will always be given adequate notice for assignments.
